WELCOME TO LAS VEGAS

On behalf of Chicago Title, we proudly present our Las Vegas Relocation Guide. If you are moving or planning to move to Las Vegas, this guide will give you some important information you'll need to start your new life here.

At one time considered a famed resort exclusively for the purpose of entertainment and gaming, our Valley continues to grow into a positive community adapting to the needs of all family life. With its growing economy, low overall taxes, and favorable cost of living, the population of Clark County continues to climb. According to the Clark County Comprehensive of Planning, the total population in Clark County is estimated to be 2,325,798 people. Clark Country includes the

cities of Las Vegas, Boulder City, Henderson, Mesquite, and North Las Vegas.

Las Vegas is a subtropical desert climate. The city enjoys abundant sunshine year-round: it has an average of about 300 sunny days per year with more than 3,800 hours of sunshine, the chances of a rain-out or (snow-out in winter are slim). The Nevada climate offers outdoor enthusiasts the ultimate playground. In the warmer months, Valley residents visit the nearby mountains and lakes to enjoy hiking and water sports. During the mild and pleasant fall & winter months, there are plenty of activities from which to choose including many events and activities as well a great selection of golf courses.



The very same bright sunshine, superb recreational opportunities, and first-rate attractions that draw millions of tourist and seasonal visitors have made the Valley one of the most popular relocation destinations in the nation.



THE HISTORY OF LAS VEGAS

Las Vegas ("The Meadows" in Spanish) was **founded** as a city on May 15, 1905. The Nevada Legislature created Clark County on July 1, 1909. The new county was named after William Clark, who brought the railroad to southern Nevada. Las Vegas became the county seat. At that time, Las Vegas was only 19.18 square miles and had a population of approximately 800, less than one percent of the state's total population.

On March 19, 1911, **gambling is legalized** in the State of Nevada. One month later the city issues six gambling licenses. Beginning in 1931, the construction of **Hoover Dam** brings an influx of construction workers which starts a **population boom** and gives the Valley's economy, which was in the grips of the **Great Depression**, a needed boost.

The outbreak of **World War II** brings the defense industry to the valley. The isolated location, along with plentiful water and inexpensive energy, makes Las Vegas an ideal site for **military and defense-related industries**. The site for Nellis Air Force Base is located in the northeast, and the Basic Management Complex, providers of raw materials, is located in the southeastern suburb of Henderson. The defense industry continues to employ a significant number of valley residents. In 1945, following World War II, lavishly decorated

resort hotels and gambling casinos offering top-name entertainment come into existence. **Tourism and entertainment** take over as the largest employer in the valley.

In 1969, **Elvis Presley** opens at the International Hotel, now known as the Las Vegas Hilton.

Starting in the mid-1980s, a **period of unprecedented growth** begins. Annual population increases averaging nearly seven percent causes the city's population to almost double between 1985 and 1995, increasing from 186,380 to 368,360. Clark County's population increases from 562,280 to 1,036,180. The US Census reports the population of Las Vegas is 478,434 over a land area of 113 square miles. There are over 500 churches and synagogues, 799 acres of parks, 7 television stations and 12 radio stations (4 AM and 8 FM). Las Vegas is the **largest metropolitan city in the U.S. that was founded in the 20th century**.

The city of Las Vegas celebrated its **100th birthday** on May 15, 2005. The events celebrated the 1905 auction in which 110 acres of downtown Las Vegas laid the foundation for the city we know today. The celebration began on December 31, 2004, and lasted throughout 2005.



STATE FUN FACTS

- Nevada was **named after the mountain range** in the west. From out at sea, Spanish sailors gazed upon the beautiful mountain ranges in California. They called these mountains, **Sierra Nevada**, giving the origin of the state's name "snow-capped" in Spanish.
- Nevada has **more mountain ranges than any other state**, with its highest point at the 13,145 top of Boundary Peak near the west-central border.
- In 1899 Charles Fey invented a **slot machine** named the Liberty Bell. The device became the model for all slots to follow.
- Locals use terms like; The Sagebrush State, The Silver State, and The Battle Born State as **nicknames** for Nevada.
- Nevada is the **largest gold-producing state** in the nation. It is second in the world behind South Africa.
- The only Nevada lake with an outlet to the sea is man made **Lake Mead**.

DID YOU KNOW?

The state of Nevada gained its nickname "**Battle Born**" because it was one of only two states admitted to the Union amidst the **Civil War**. Nevada achieved statehood on October 31, 1864, becoming the 36th state to join the Union.



The present **Nevada flag** is a beautiful cobalt blue, with a symbolic pattern in the upper left portion. The springs of sagebrush indicate that the yellow sagebrush is the national flower of the state. The state's nickname, "Battle born," is shown on the ribbon. The silver star stands not only for the state of Nevada, but also for the rich deposits of state mineral wealth.

VOTING & ELECTIONS IN CLARK COUNTY, NV

Preliminary Elections

- **Primary Elections:** For most non-presidential candidates, closed primary elections are held at party-specific events (Democrat or Republican). Only registered voters affiliated with these parties can participate.
- **Presidential Elections:** Nevada uses caucuses instead of primaries for presidential elections. Caucuses are also party-specific and require voters to be registered and affiliated with either the Democratic or Republican Party.
- **Caucus Process:** Democratic caucuses involve voters gathering into preference groups, while Republican caucuses use a straw poll with anonymous ballots. Delegates elected at caucuses represent their counties at the state convention, leading to national convention representation.

General Elections

- **Voting Locations:** In general elections, voters can cast their ballots at any designated voting location within their precinct. Early voting sites are available a few weeks before Election Day.
- **Election Day:** Election Day is the first Tuesday after November 1st. Voters must present a valid government-issued ID to receive a card for the voting machine.
- **Ballot Initiatives:** Voters can choose candidates and referenda that directly represent their electoral subdivisions, from local to federal levels.

Voter Registration

- **Eligibility:** To register to vote, you must be a U.S. citizen, at least 18 years old by the next election date, and have lived in Nevada and your precinct for the required periods.

- **Registration Methods:** You can register online, by mail, or in person at the Clark County Election Department or the Department of Motor Vehicles.
- **Contact Information:** For mail-in applications, contact the Clark County Election Department at (702) 455-8083. More information is available on the Nevada Secretary of State's website and the Clark County Election Department's website.

Additional Information

- **Mail Ballots:** Nevada conducts all-mail ballot elections, but in-person voting is still available. Voters can track their mail ballots online.
- **Same-Day Registration:** Available at Early Voting sites and Election Day Vote Centers with valid ID.
- **Election Security:** Measures are in place to ensure the integrity of the voting process, including secure ballot handling and auditing procedures.

MASTER PLANNED COMMUNITIES

WEST

ALIANTE 1165 acres of residential development, 100 acres for shopping, dining, and entertainment venues within the community, 428 acres dedicated to recreation and public use.

CANYON GATE Located on approximately 550 acres, this is one of the smaller, gated golf course communities. Good infrastructure, 6 miles from the strip and 2 miles east of Summerlin.

DESERT SHORES located just north and east of Summerlin, this community features man-made lakes that are very accessible and stocked for fishing. Condos, lakefront homes, gated communities, and moderately priced to higher-end tract homes are available here.

THE LAKES Located directly west of the Las Vegas Strip off Sahara Ave. Features lakefront properties, tract homes and condos. This is a mature community. It has a lot of esthetic appeal with lakes, jogging trails, and such.

LOS PRADOS Most affordable of all the guard-gated golf communities. Other amenities include 2 pools (one for adults, one for children), clubhouse, tennis courts, and a recreation center.

LYNBROOK This is a planned community in the far northwest. It features 10 communities with 4 wooded parks, pathways, and ponds. Some communities are gated and some are not. It is located in North Las Vegas, just east of Decatur and off of Farm Rd. Houses range from 1,000 to 4,000 sq. ft.

MOUNTAIN'S EDGE A master planned community where the legends of the old west meet the luxuries of enlightened community design, with 12,500 lots located on 3,500 acres in the southwest. There are six parks connected by a series of paseos for walking and biking.

PAINTED DESERT This community is located in the northwest, just southwest of the US-95 and Ann Rd. It comprises around 1500 homes, townhomes, and condos on 460 acres.

PECCOLE RANCH Located directly north across Sahara Ave. from The Lakes and directly east of Summerlin, this community is networked with green-belts and walking paths.

PROVIDENCE Providence is a master planned community on 1,200 acres in northwest Las Vegas, just off of the Clark County 215 beltway and Hualapai Rd. Providence will feature 30 unique neighborhoods with new homes and condominiums. There will be approximately 7,500 residences. Providence will also feature tree-lined boulevards and 10 miles of trails. The developer has set aside 33 acres for parks. The community will feature roughly 4,000 trees in all."

QUEENSRIDGE A 840 acre guard-gated community in northwest Las Vegas. This elegant community boasts a clubhouse, a fitness center, five private parks, and the Badlands golf-course. It is located near shopping, entertainment, and recreational facilities.

RHODES RANCH GOLF CLUB 1,300 acre community with guard-gated entry. Executive, semi-custom, and custom homes are built around an 18 hole golf course. Fountains, lakes, and hundreds of palm trees grace this community. The development will include 3,200 homes at build-out.

SILVERSTONE RANCH Golf course community presently being developed by Pulte in the far northwest part of the valley. Six collections of homes ranging from 1,348 to 3,448 sq. ft. surround the Silverstone Golf Club.



MASTER PLANNED COMMUNITIES (CONT.)

SOUTHERN HIGHLANDS 2,300 acres set in the foothills of southwest Las Vegas. Planned amenities for the community include hiking, jogging, bike trails, parks, a marketplace, and a business center. The nationally ranked Southern Highlands Golf Club is the perfect setting for the custom home area, The Estates.

SUMMERLIN 22,500 acres with 90 neighborhood and village parks, more than 90 miles of recreational trails, and eight golf courses, including two Tournament Player's Club courses. Summerlin has 16 schools and a College of Southern Nevada facility. Other amenities include medical centers, business parks, cultural centers, and shopping centers. Today, there are more than 50 neighborhoods in Summerlin; some are age-qualified.

EAST

ANTHEM Anthem contains 5,000 acres and has a population of 30,000. The guard-gated country club area and the age-qualified neighborhood are distinctive features of Anthem. Common amenities include commercial centers, a 55 acre city park, nature trails, and landscaped common areas.

GREEN VALLEY 7,100 acre community with 74,000 residents. One of the most successful master planned communities, Green Valley offers single family residences, affordable townhomes, custom homes and estates, and luxury apartments. There are many schools, public and private golf courses, shopping, dining, and entertainment centers.

GREEN VALLEY RANCH 1,310 acres with 775 acres of residential neighborhoods and 310 acres of retail, medical, and a hotel. Parks, schools, recreation centers, churches, and bike paths occupy more than 200 acres.

INSPIRADA A bold, new master planned community in Henderson, Nevada gives all the inspired amenities of a pedestrian-friendly city balanced with a relaxing and picturesque suburban setting. Located just minutes from the I-15 freeway with easy access to the Las Vegas Strip. This community is next door to Anthem and also borders the 50,000 acre Sloan Canyon federal preserve.

LAKE LAS VEGAS RESORT Lake Las Vegas Resort is a \$5 billion, 2,600 acre residential and resort community that surrounds a privately owned, 320 acre lake with 10 miles of shoreline. An internationally recognized project, Lake Las Vegas, includes 6 luxury hotels, 5 championship golf courses, world class shopping and dining, custom and semi-custom estates, single-family residences, and a 20 acre wetland park.

MACDONALD RANCH A 3,200 acre development with 4 villages. Central to McDonald Ranch is Del Webb's Sun City (55+). It features an 18 hole golf course and a community center. It also features homes as expensive as \$20 million. There are approximately 2,400 homes in this project.

SEVEN HILLS Expansive views of the city and the mountains to the south and west. This 1300 acre community features homes in varying price ranges including a custom estate neighborhood. With the exception of a few custom lots, this community is sold out.

SILVERADO RANCH The closest commute to the Strip/airport of all the master planned communities. Houses, condos, and apartments are available."

TUSCANY Another guard-gated golf community by Rhodes Homes. Located in Henderson, east of Boulder Highway close to Lake Las Vegas.

CLARK COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Clark County School District (CCSD) has always placed a strong emphasis on providing its students with a great education. Today, CCSD and its schools continue to win national recognition and awards. For example, 35 CCSD Magnet programs received honors from Magnet Schools of America for the 2023-24 school year.

The current enrollment in CCSD is approximately 304,565 students. CCSD services a very large area, including Las Vegas, North Las Vegas, Henderson, Boulder City, Indian Springs, Mesquite, Laughlin, Searchlight, Sandy Valley, and rural areas in Clark County.

As of the 2023-2024 school year, CCSD is the 5th largest school district in the United States and includes 373 schools: 233 elementary schools, 61 middle schools, 54 high schools, 21 alternative schools, and 4 special schools. CCSD is also the largest employer in the State of Nevada, with over 43,786 employees.

Children between the ages of six and 17 years are required by Nevada law to attend school. Here is some valuable information for parents of students enrolling in the Clark County School District. **(For more info, visit www.ccsd.net.)**

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

Age Requirements:

- To enroll in Kindergarten, children must be 5 years old on or before August 1st.
- To enroll in first grade, children must be 6 years old on or before August 1st and must have completed kindergarten.

OR demonstrate proof of completing kindergarten and promotion to first grade while being a resident of another state/ country in compliance with the age and entrance requirements of that same state/ country.

Required Documents:

- Two forms of proof of residence (utility bill, lease/rent receipt, sales contract, etc.)
- Child official identification records (original certified birth certificate, passport, or certified birth card) and Parent or Guardian's ID
- Immunization records

NOTE: Previous school records, recent report cards, achievement test scores, and information about special health conditions can expedite the enrollment process and ensure proper placement.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

- **Kindergarten:** Five DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis), four Polio, and two MMR (Measles, Mumps, and Rubella) vaccinations
- **New to Nevada Schools:** Two Hepatitis A shots, three Hepatitis B shots, and two Chickenpox (Varicella) shots. (The Health Department offers Hepatitis A and Chickenpox vaccinations for a \$15 administration fee.)
- **College Freshmen:** Tetanus and MMR boosters.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS

- **Academic Programs:** Bilingual and English as Second Language (ESL), reinforced reading, Gifted And Talented Education (GATE), honors programs, and Advanced Placement classes.
- **International Baccalaureate (IB):** Offered at Valley High School and Green Valley High School.
- **Career and Technical Academies:** 37 magnet schools, including 10 elementary schools, 10 middle schools, and 17 high schools specializing in areas such as performing arts, international studies, travel and tourism, math, science, communications, and aerospace technology

FREMONT STREET EXPERIENCE

A mega million dollar canopy and light show shrouds the original Downtown Las Vegas Fremont Street and is really a sight to behold. It presently starts at 8:00pm with shows every hour on the and finishes at midnight. The show is approximately 12 minutes long.

The garden is over 13,500 square feet and has 1,200 bins of exotic plants. The Conservatory & Botanical Gardens at the Bellagio is open 24 hours, 7 days a week.

This iconic sign is a must-visit for anyone coming to Las Vegas. It's a great spot for photos and is located at the south end of the Strip.

FLAMINGO WILDLIFE HABITAT




